




2017 Crime in Montana Summary




Trends in the Number of Index Violent Crimes



Highlights

- Violent Crime ▲ 5% in 2017
- Violent Crime ▲ 30% since 2013
- Homicides ▲ 68% from 2013, yet ▼ 27% since 2015
- Rape ▲ 32% since 2013
- Aggravated assaults ▲ 30% since 2013
- Robbery lowest 5-year ▲ of 22%


Trends in the Number of Index Property Crimes



Highlights


- \$53,605,665 in 2017 property loss ▼ 8% from 2016
- Total Property Crimes ▼ 3% in 2017
- Total Property Crimes ▲ 11% since 2013
- Larceny/Theft ▼ .6% from 2017 yet ▲ 52% from 2013
- Motor Vehicle Theft ▼ 2% from 2017, yet ▲ 10% from 2013
- Burglary ▼ 9% from 2017 and ▼ 4.6 since 2013

2017 Substance Abuse Crimes



Highlights

- Drug Reports ▲ 8% in 2017, and ▲ 49% since 2013
- Methamphetamine ▲ 175% from 2013
- Opioids/Heroin ▲ 29% since 2013
- Unknown drug types ▼ 5% since 2013
- Marijuana ▲ 22% since 2013



Highlights

- Sheriff and Police data reported separate from Highway Patrol prior to 2017 (data shown is unduplicated)
- Total DUI citations ▲ 10% from 2013
- Highway Patrol ▼ 3% in 2017, yet ▲ 12% since 2013
- Sheriff and Police ▼ 6% in 2015, yet ▲ 10% since 2013
