



Type of Drug Measurement

When do I use the XX, Not Reported Type of Drug Measurement?

If a substance is sent to a laboratory for analysis and a response has not yet been received, enter XX, Not Reported for the Type of Drug Measurement.

U, Unknown should be entered for the Suspected Drug Type with a XX, Not Reported Type of Drug Measurement.

1, None should be entered for the Estimated Drug Quantity with a XX, Not Reported Type of Drug Measurement.

Once the Drug has been determined by the laboratory, the Known values should be entered for Suspected Drug Type, Estimated Drug Quantity & Type of Drug Measurement. This new information must be resubmitted to update previously submitted Incidents.

For example: A bag of white powder, suspected to be drugs, was seized. The powder was sent to the laboratory for analysis. <u>U, Unknown</u> is recorded for the Suspected Drug Type, <u>1, None</u> for Estimated Drug Quantity & <u>XX, Not Reported</u> for the Type of Drug Measurement pending laboratory results.
