

How do I use the new Exceptional Clearance code C, In Custody of Other Jurisdiction?

Each agency has an option on how to use this code.

Your agency can:

- 1. wait until the individual is returned and clear the incident by arrest, or
- 2. clear the incident immediately by using the C, In Custody of Other Jurisdiction exceptional clearance code.

For example, an individual is being held at a detention center elsewhere and your agency wants to bring him/her back to your jurisdiction for previously committed crimes. A detainer is placed on him/her until the individual is released from the agency currently holding the individual.

It is your agency's decision on which option to report:

- 1. show a physical arrest when you gain custody of the arrestee, or
- 2. use the exceptional clearance code C, In Custody of Other Jurisdiction prior to gaining custody of the arrestee.
