

How to select a Motor Vehicle Theft Rate per 1,000 Crime Map

- 1. Click on the <u>drop down arrow</u> to the right of **Measure**;
- 2. Click on Motor Vehicle Theft Rate per 1,000;
- 3. Click on the drop down arrow to the right of **Select choices for all Parameters, then click [View Report]**;
- 4. Click on 2011;
- 5. Click on the drop down arrow to the right of Geography Level;
- 6. Click on County; then
- 7. Click on the **View Report** button.
- 8. When reviewing the map, refer to the color key in the lower left corner of the map. (Green = Below average state crime rate, Yellow = Within average state crime rate, Red = Above average state crime rate)
- 9. Click on a County and you will be directed to MTIBRS Online Reporting for more detailed information.

The map should look like the one on page 2.
