

New Prostitution Offense Definition

Purchasing Prostitution - MTIBRS code 1641
To purchase or trade anything of value for commercial sex acts.

New Human Trafficking Offense Definitions

The inducement of a person to perform a commercial sex act, or labor, or services, through <u>force, fraud, or coercion</u>. Human trafficking has also occurred if a person under 18 years of age has been induced, or enticed, regardless of force, fraud, or coercion, to perform a commercial sex act.

- 1. Human Trafficking, Commercial Sex Acts MTIBRS code 2920 Inducing a person by <u>force</u>, <u>fraud</u>, <u>or coercion</u> to participate in commercial sex acts, or in which the person induced to perform such act(s) has not attained 18 years of age.
- 2. Human Trafficking, Involuntary Servitude MTIBRS code 2930 The obtaining of a person(s) through recruitment, harboring, transportation, or provision, and subjecting such persons by <u>force</u>, <u>fraud</u>, <u>or coercion</u> into voluntary servitude, peonage, debt bondage, or slavery (not to include commercial sex acts).
