Multi-jurisdictional Drug Task Force Related

This Data Element is to be used to indicate whether the offense involved in an incident was related to multi-jurisdictional drug task force involvement.

The allowable Data Values are:

- I = Investigated** - This is used when an officer affiliated with the MJDTF spends time investigating an incident/case.
- R = Referred** - This is used when a local law enforcement agency refers the incident to the MJDTF in their area.
- N = Not Applicable** - This is used when an MJDTF is not involved in the incident.

Multi-jurisdictional Drug Task Force Related

This field needs a code entered for each offense. It is not just applicable to drug offenses.

How do you use the Data Values I & R:

I = Investigated is used when an officer affiliated with the MJDTF in your area spends time investigating an incident/case.

R = Referred is used when a local law enforcement agency refers an incident to the MJDTF in their area for further action.

It is NOT to be used when a local law enforcement agency shares an incident report with the MJDTF in their area for informational or Intel purposes.
