



Who is a victim of crime & which one do I report?

Each incident <u>must</u> include a victim. According to the offense, a victim can be an individual, business, financial institution, government, law enforcement officer, religious organization, society/public, other or unknown.

It is recommended that **ALL** victims <u>affected</u> by the offense be included in your incident.

Who is a victim of crime & which one do I report?

Example 1: When a SNAP card is stolen, enter the individual owner of the card & government.

Example 2: A father, mother & daughter live together. There residence is burglarized. Specific items that belonged to the father were stolen. Some of his daughter's items were stolen, also. The victims entered should be the father & the daughter.

Example 3: In a bank robbery, the victim would be the Financial Institution, but the teller toward whom the robber pointed a gun and made a demand should also be reported as a victim.
