Reporting Homicides

The following should be reported to MTIBRS if known to law enforcement:

Deliberate Homicide

The willful (nonnegligent) killing of one human being by another.

MTIBRS code 0111 or 0112

Negligent Manslaughter

The killing of another person through negligence.

MTIBRS code 0121

Justifiable Homicide

The killing of a perpetrator of a serious criminal offense by a peace officer in the line of duty, or the killing, during the commission of a serious criminal offense, of the perpetrator by a private individual.

MTIBRS code 0131

MTIBRS “Tip” on reporting Crime Data



When reporting a murder/suicide incident, the incident with the reported homicide can be cleared exceptionally with the A = Death of Offender Exceptional Clearance code.

Note: The findings of a court, coroner’s inquest, etc., should not influence the reporting of offenses in this category.
