- ◇ Across Montana, youth are making personal commitments to end youth violence.

2015-16 Do the *Write* Thing Timeline

September 2015: Teachers and students begin the prewriting and writing process.

February 19, 2016: Student writings are due at the Board of Crime Control.

April 30, 2016: State Do the *Write* Thing Celebration will be held in Helena.

July 2016: National Do the *Write* Thing Celebration will be held in Washington, D.C.
