

Statistical Analysis Center Montana Incident-Based Reporting System (MTIBRS) Proposed Quality Assurance Review (QAR) Process

- Step 1 Risk assessment for all NIBRS reporters for the year: The risk assessment will be run in March for all NIBRS reporting agencies, regardless of how many months were reported. The assessment will look at factors that could impact the quality of data. See the risk assessment for the topics and risk assessed topics.
- Step 2 Determine the cutoff score for agencies to receive a QAR: Based on the scores, the SAC will determine a cut off for those agencies we feel may need our assistance to improve data quality. Agencies may receive a visit each year if there are a number of ongoing issues. Agencies may also receive a quality assurance review using Zoom or Teams particularly if there are very few issues.
- Step 3 Based on risk score, schedule in person reviews first, then zoom reviews at least 30 days out: If you receive a notice for a review, it will also come with reports that summarize your MTIBRS data and will highlight in priority order those issues that may indicate data quality concerns. (See example) The notice will also include if anything is needed during the meeting to better discuss solutions to the identified concerns.
- **Step 4** Review meeting: During the meeting, we will go over
 - * risk assessment score
 - * data errors
 - * outstanding errors
 - * warnings
 - * arrest issues
 - index crime changes >5% and agency comparison differences indicating potential problems
 - * previous QAR tasks not completed
 - * outstanding issues for: Bias, Hate, LEOKA, UoF, DICRA, burglaries, homicides, human trafficking
 - * new features or data fields
 - property issues
 - * random incidents if requested in the notice
 - * any additional questions covered in the review notice
 - * flagged FBI questionnaire issues

Together we will create follow-up tasks with due dates for your agency, our agency, your RMS vendor, the MTIBRS vendor or others as needed to resolve the identified issue. Note, we will limit the number of follow-up tasks. Our goal to help you succeed in making data easier to enter, more reliable and easier to access.

Step 5 The Final Report: After follow-up tasks have been completed and reported on by all those assigned, a final report of the review will be made available to you. In the future, these review summaries will be available in MTIBRS. Look for this feature in 2022!


Offense: Violent Crimes




