

MTIBRS Status Reports & Automated Data Submissions

Upcoming MTIBRS Status Reports

- Errors not cleared
- Warnings not cleared
- Missing agency months
- Outstanding offenses
 - Cargo Thefts
 - ▶ Hate Crimes
 - Burglaries premises entered
 - ► Homicides
 - Human trafficking
 - Justifiable Homicide
 - **LEOKA**



MTIBRS Status Reports MAY Include

- User Information Update
- Agency Information Update
 - May or may not be included in the status report
 - This information we be reviewed annually by your Analyst
 - Your Analyst will also review your Memorandum of Understanding for data sharing
- ► These reports will be sent the first working day of the month.

New Law Enforcement Survey Workflow



- Initial notice and instructions will go out the first working day of November
- For those who have not yet completed the survey after 15 days, a reminder will be sent
- ► A second reminder will be sent if not completed after 30 days
- We will start calling folks after 30 days

Law Enforcement Survey Notice Includes

- ► The notice will:
 - ▶ Give a link to instructions on our website
 - ▶ It will show the last 5 years of submissions
 - The notice will also include who completed the survey each year
 - If the survey was completed by MBCC Staff, call us. We probably sent you a fillable table to make it easier to complete

Scheduled XML Submissions

- Scheduled Submissions > Manual Submissions
 - ► Ease of reporting without stress of monthly deadline
 - ► NIBRS in the background (where it belongs!)
 - ► Early detection of issues
 - ▶ Utilizing the MTIBRS Status report
 - Errors & warnings report
 - > Agency, officer or vendor specific issues
 - Crime Trends
 - More consistent & quality data patterns
 - ► Timelier picture of crime in Montana for all partners
