**LEOKA: Law Enforcement Officers
Killed or Assaulted**

History of LEOKA

- ▶ Line of duty deaths have been collected & published since 1937
- ▶ Data involving assaults on officers began in 1960
- ▶ In 1972 the FBI produced two reports annually, the Law Enforcement Officers Killed Summary the & Analysis of Assaults on Federal Officers.
- ▶ In 1982 these reports were combined to create the annual publication, Law Enforcement Officers Killed and Assaulted.

LEOKA Criteria

- ▶ Data pertains to felonious deaths, accidental deaths and assaults of duly sworn city, university and college, county, state, tribal and federal law enforcement officers who, at the time of the incident:
 - ▶ Wore/carried a badge
 - ▶ Carried a firearm
 - ▶ Duly sworn with full arrest powers
 - ▶ Active members of a law enforcement agency
 - ▶ Were acting in an official capacity - on or off duty
 - ▶ If killed, the death was directly related to injuries received during an incident

LEOKA Exclusions:

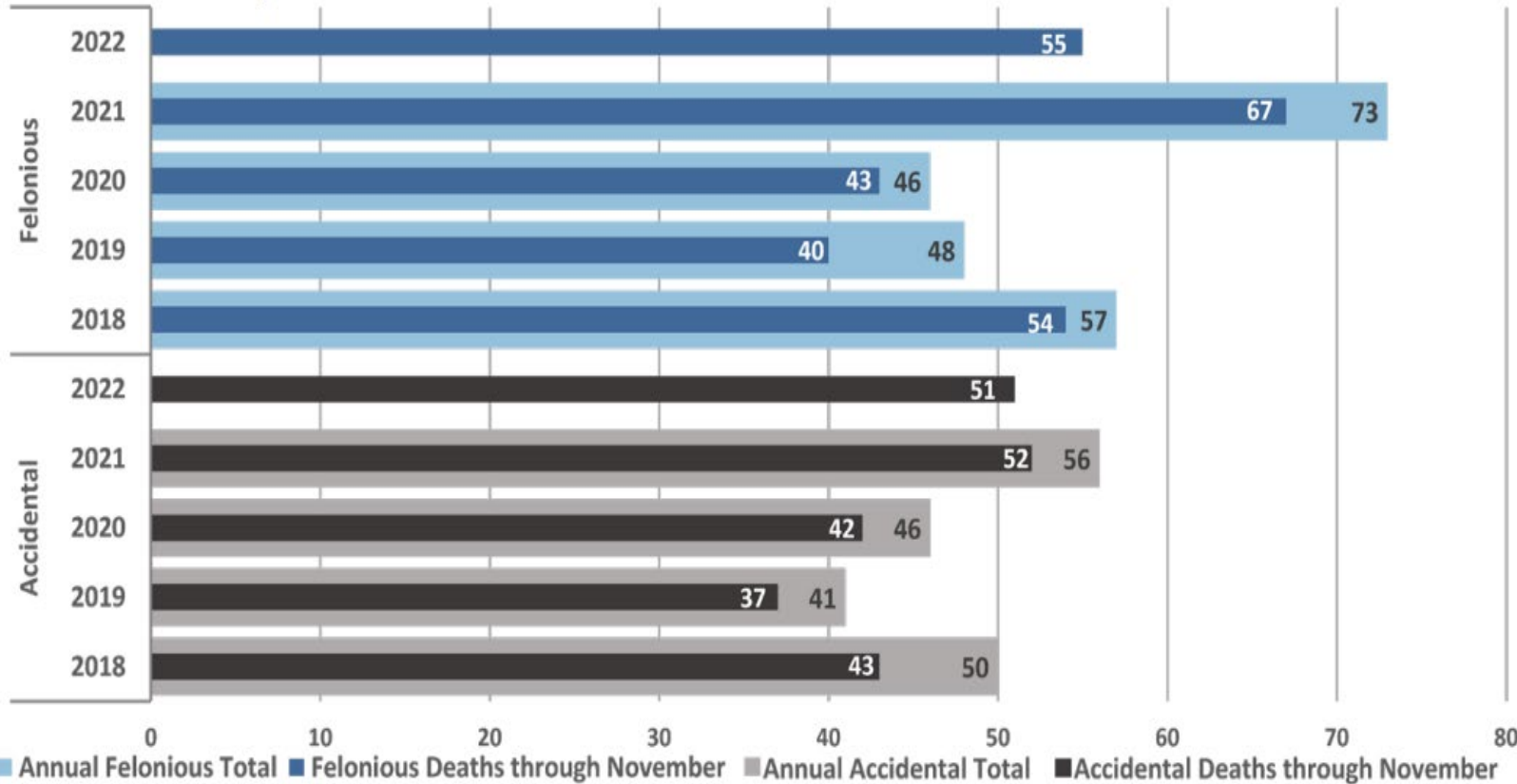
- ▶ Exclusions, though it occurred on duty:
 - ▶ Natural causes such as heart attack, stroke, aneurism, etc.
 - ▶ Death attributed to their own personal situation such as DV, neighbor conflict, etc.
 - ▶ Suicide

LEOKA Reporting

- ▶ Your RMS automatically submits all details regarding law enforcement assaults to NIBRS
- ▶ FBI LEOKA documents required **ONLY** if:
 - ▶ **Officer Death - Felonious**
 - ▶ **Officer Death - Accidental**
- ▶ SAC Staff will assist with the process & submit to LEEP on behalf of the agency

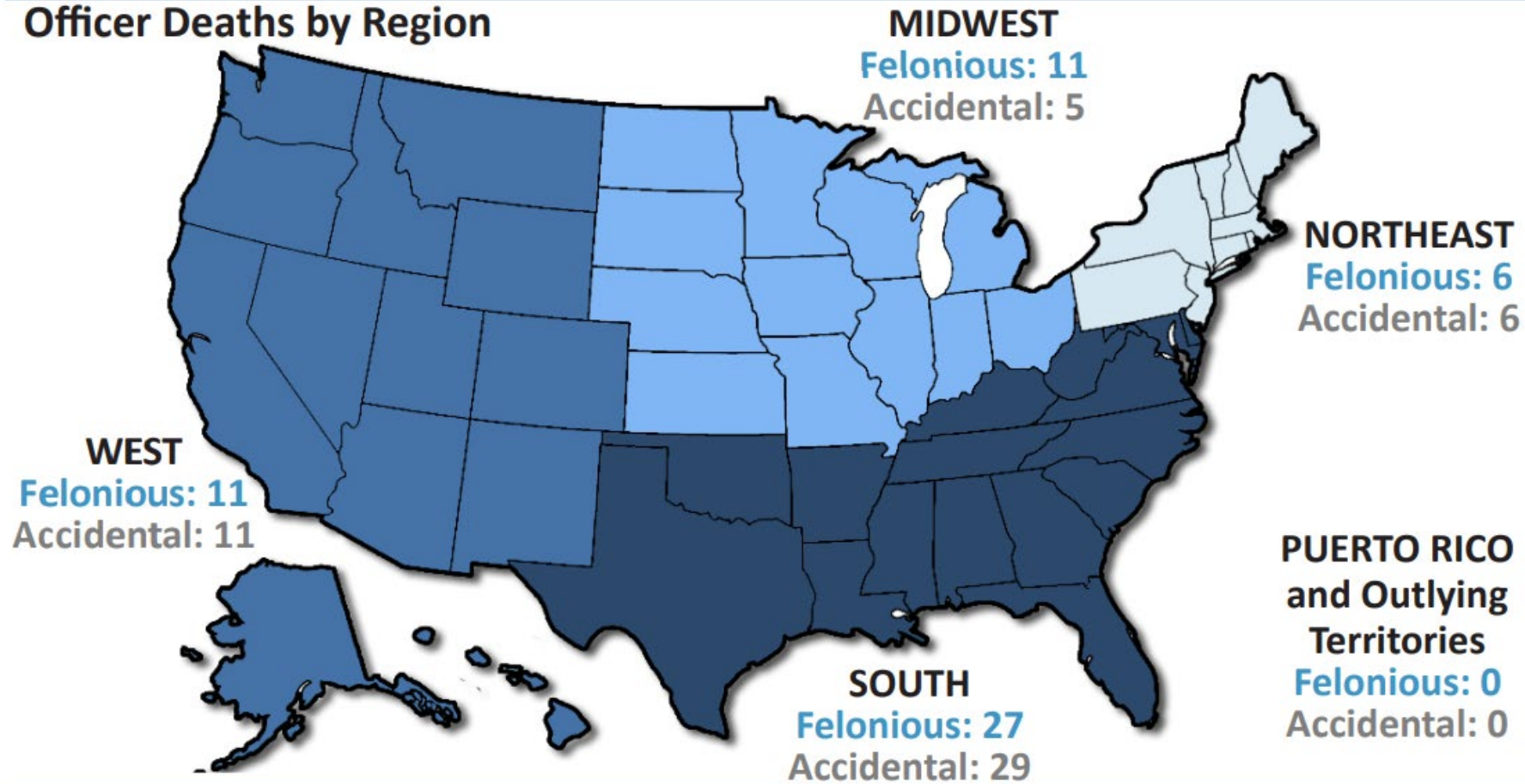
