### NEIGHBORHOOD INVESTIGATION CHECKLIST

In almost all endangered missing or abducted children investigations a thorough neighborhood investigation is essential and must be implemented as soon as possible, utilizing as much information as is available to investigators at the time.

The following procedures are intended as guidelines, specific procedures may not necessarily apply to every case. The listed procedures should be implemented when the facts of the case dictate.

- > Check off each assignment as completed.
- Assignments requiring follow up should be annotated with the name/ID of the person making the assignment
- > Document the name and ID of the person assigned the task
- Annotate the date and time the task was completed.
- > Standardized forms should be attached to this checklist for documentation.

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#### **INITIAL INFORMATION GATHERING**

Prior to initiating the canvass and as soon as possible after being advised of a child abduction, information gathering should begin. This process may be conducted by trained Crime Analysis personnel or experienced investigators. Information must be accurate and timely. This information will be provided to investigators in the field for use in the investigation and the area canvass.
