

## Statewide Sequential Intercept Model Mapping (SIMM) Summit


About the event: DPHHS, in collaboration with Policy Research Associates (PRA) is hosting a statewide SIMM Summit. This summit is aimed at identifying and responding to the mental health needs of individuals who are involved or at risk for involvement in the criminal justice system.

The summit is designed to bring together local, cross-system, multi-disciplinary stakeholders to facilitate collaboration, and identify ways in which barriers between the criminal justice and behavioral health systems can be reduced through the development of local strategic plans via an 'intercept' process (pictured below).

While many SIMM models have been created at local levels in Montana, interest has been expressed in completing at the statewide level to identify resources that exist cross-regionally, identify gaps and barriers to these services/resources, and reduce some of the siloed work that may exist in behavioral health and criminal justice services in Montana.

**Outcomes:** In addition to regional strategic action plans and comprehensive reports of gaps in services and opportunities for improvement at each intercept, other outcomes to expect of this event will be the creation of regional 'intercept' maps along with an online dashboard/repository of these identified services across Montana. Additionally, ongoing (virtual) TA calls by region will be hosted by PRA.
