VOCA subrecipient organizations must use volunteers, <u>94.113</u>, unless MBCC determines there is a compelling reason to waive this requirement. A "compelling reason" may be the inability to recruit and maintain volunteers after a sustained and aggressive effort. Volunteers must perform activities that support crime victims to qualify under this requirement.
