# Purpose of Title II Funds

- Prevent Juvenile Delinquency
- Improve the Juvenile Justice System
- Protect Children and the Public

## OJJDP Core Requirements

- 1. Deinstitutionalization of status offenders
- 2. Separation of juveniles from adult inmates
- 3. Removal of juveniles from adult jails and lockups
- 4. Addressing racial and ethnic disparities

### Youth Justice Council

#### • Purpose:

- Monitor state compliance with OJJDP requirements
- Participate in the development and review of the state's juvenile justice plan
- Reviews all grant applications
- Seek regular input from juveniles under the jurisdiction of the juvenile justice system and state, local, and private agencies to better coordinate services

#### • Current Projects:

- Three-Year Plan
- Increasing tribal outreach efforts
- Delinquency Prevention Grant



# JJDPA Reauthorization 2018 Highlights

- Conduct evidence-based mental health and substance abuse screening, assessment, and treatment
  - Linking Systems of Care
- Collaboration with Title I to ensure that credits are transferred between local schools and secure facilities
- Plan to identify and divert youth victims of domestic human trafficking
- State Advisory Groups must have representation from individuals who are or have been under the jurisdiction of the juvenile justice system (or a parent/guardian)

Narrative and Financial reports (quarterly) Due ten days after the end of each quarter (1/10, 4/10, 7/10, 10/10)

# Reporting cont.

- Racial/Ethnic Disparities (quarterly)
  - Number of youth served during reporting period (new and continuing)
  - Number of youth completing program requirements
  - Number of youth exiting program without completing requirements
  - Youth exhibiting positive changes in behavior and/or attitude
  - Number of youth expressing that the program has a positive impact on their lives
  - Offending/re-offending while in program

## Financial Forms



- Grant Adjustment Notification (GAN)
  - Used to move funds from one category to another
  - Request a program extension (no later than 45 days prior to the end of the project period)
  - Generally only one extension per program
- Reimbursement RequestForm
- Request and Justification for Out-of-State Travel
  - $\circ$  Completed online
