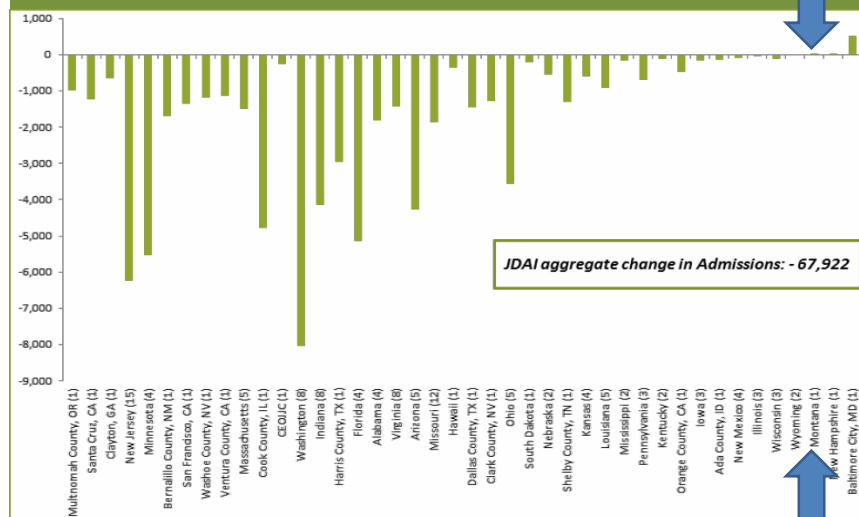

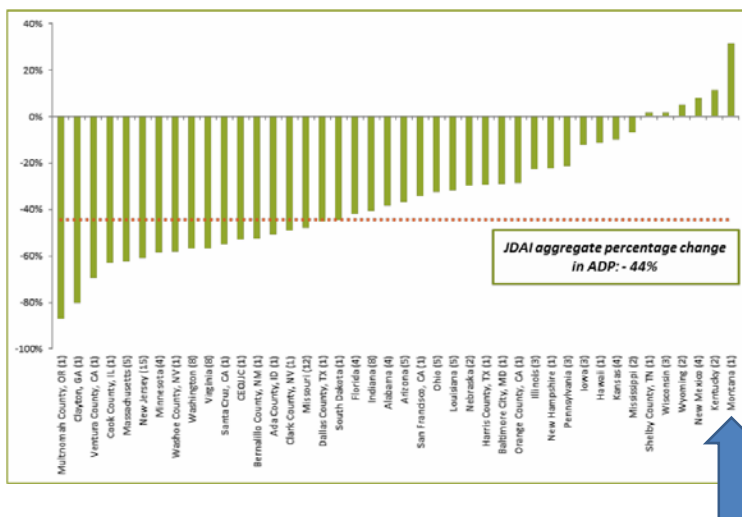

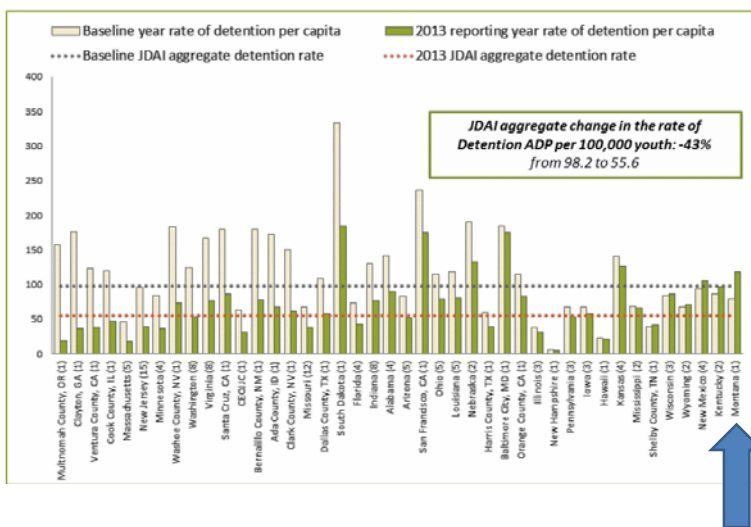
## Numerical Change in Annual Admissions from Baseline to 2013



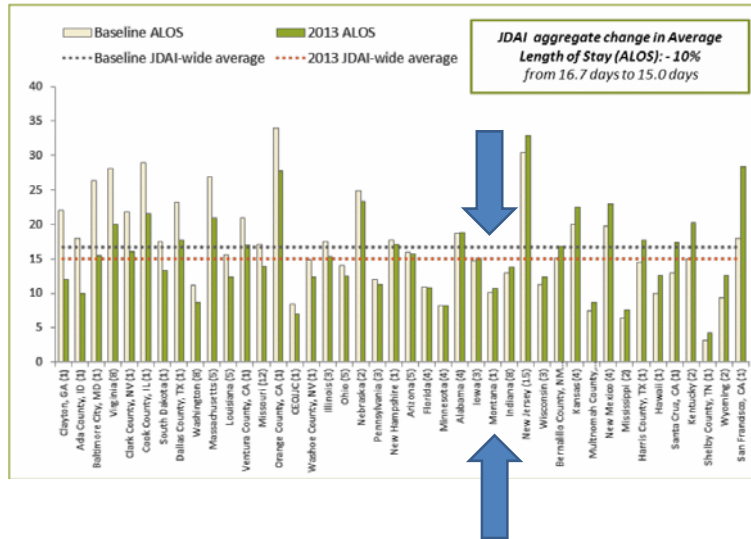
## Percent Change in ADP from Baseline to 2013, by Grantee



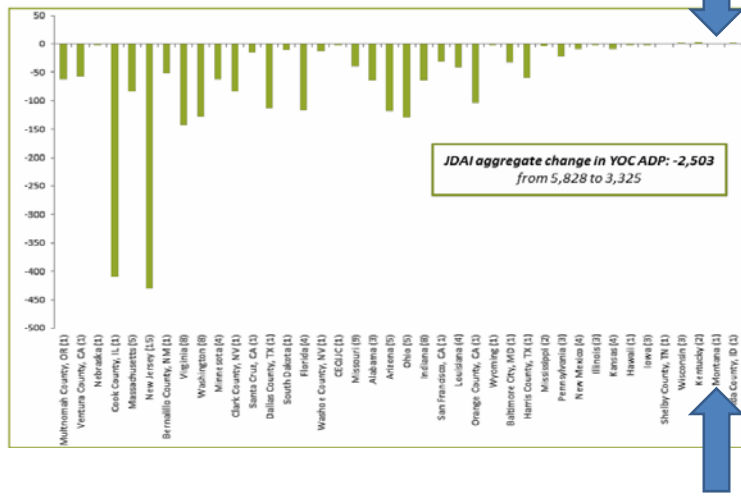
## Change in the rate of Detention ADP per 100,000 youth by Grantee



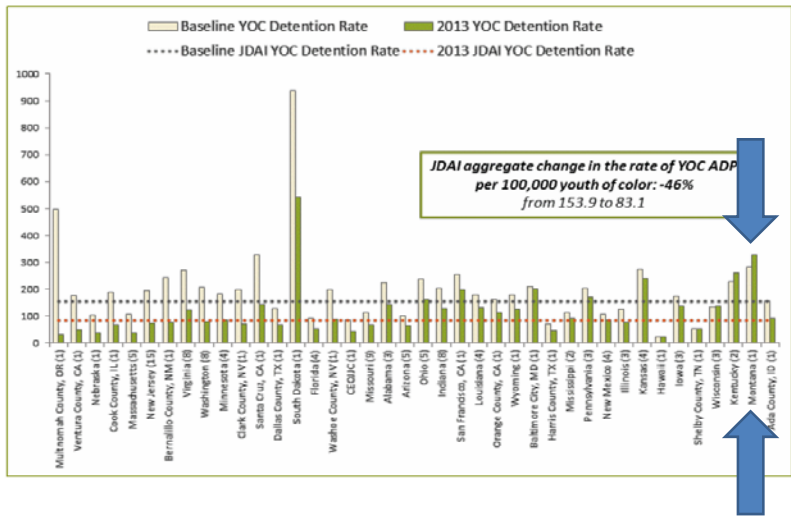
## Baseline and 2013 Detention ALOS, by Grantee



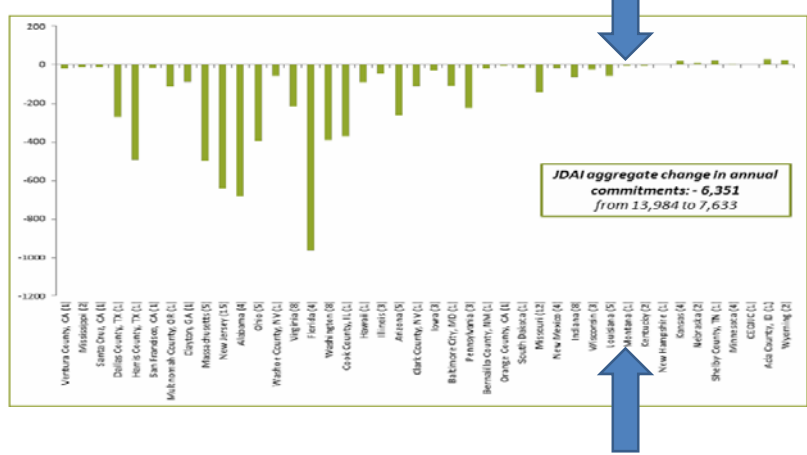
## Numerical Change in YOC Detention ADP from Baseline to 2013, by Grantee



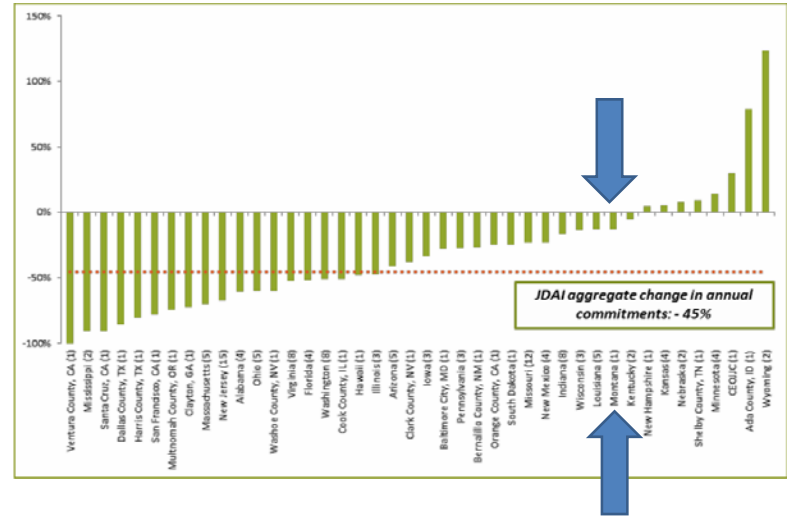
## YOC Rate of Detention per Population by Grantee, Baseline and 2013



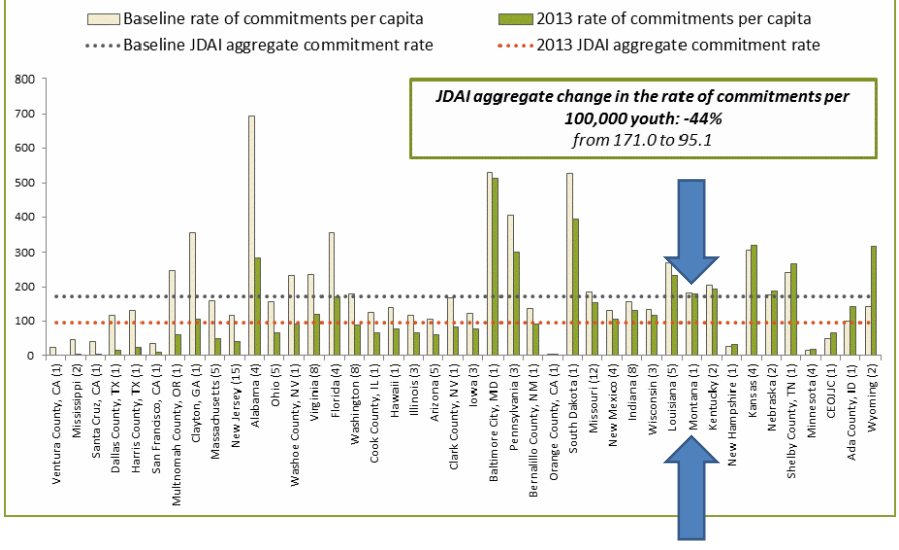
## Numerical Change in Commitments from Baseline to 2013, by Grantee



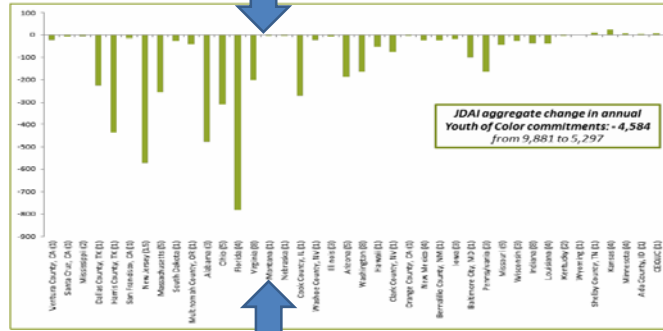
## Percent Change in Commitments from Baseline to 2013, by Grantee



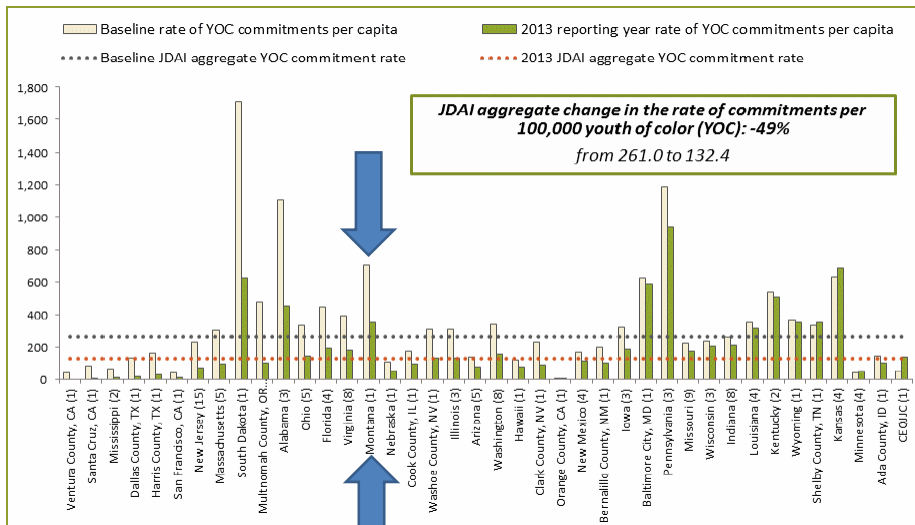
## Rate of Commitments per Youth Population by Grantee

## Data Collection Analysis and Dissemination

- Temporary Data Reporting Protocol using current Juvenile Detention Reporting System (JDRS) and AECF Quality Reporting System (QRS)
- Juvenile Detention Data and Reporting System (JDDRS) under construction that automates:
  - Detention Risk Assessment Instrument (DRAI) completion and data collection
  - JDAI Reports including AECF Quality Reporting System (QRS)

## Alignment of Policies, Practices and Programs

- A standard Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) for use by all sites
- A standard Planning Instrument for all sites
- A risk assessment instrument (RAI) for all sites
- An evaluation of the RAI was completed in 2012
- The RAI was rescored in 2013 but has not been implemented in practice as of October 2014.
- Definitions for all JDAI data elements are being programmed into the Juvenile Detention Data and Reporting System (JDDRS)
- A temporary data reporting protocol is in use until the rollout of the JDDRS
- A rescored RAI known as the detention risk assessment instrument (DRAI) has been automated within the new JDDRS to ensure it is scored the same way every time. It will be rolled out with the new JDDRS.
- JDAI Standards for Care were shared with the Detention Licensing Agent at DOC

## Quality Assurance Mechanisms

- Evaluation of RAI in 2012
- Rescore of RAI into DRAI in 2013
- Automated Detention Risk Assessment Instrument (DRAI) 2013
- Temporary use of AECF Quality Reporting System (QRS) 2012
- Incorporating QRS into JDDRS

## Embedding Reforms in Statute, Rule and Regulation

- JDAI philosophy congruent with MCA 41-5-102, Youth Court Act Declaration of Purpose
- Part 19 of Youth Court Act – Regional Detention
- Part 20 of Youth Court Act – Juvenile Delinquency Intervention Act (JDIP and PIF)
- MCA 52-2-303 Children’s System of Care Planning Committee
  - DPHHS funding for Local Crisis Intervention Services
  - SAMSHA funding for Co-occurring Disorders pilot programs
  - OVC funding for Linking Systems of Care
