- (3) Assist victims to understand and participate in the criminal justice system
- (4) Provide victims of crime with a measure of safety and security.

Funds state and local programs working to prevent juvenile delinquency; supports the wellbeing of youth involved (or risk of being involved) in the criminal justice system; sustains state-level juvenile justice reform to improve youth outcomes; works to eliminate racial and ethnic disparities in the juvenile justice system; and ensures compliance with the JJDPA Act.
